Setting: Within and without a magical tower








SYNOPSIS



Elias, a shy, gentle man born a monster, falls in love with a woman, unaware that she was created to trigger his transformation. As Elias tries to resist returning to his people, who believe he can increase their dwindling numbers, the monster inside him grows stronger. The primary conflict arises as Elias struggles to maintain control over his transformation, battling his inner monster while desperately trying to stay with his beloved. Elias attempts to harness the power of his love for the woman to overpower the monstrous instincts within him, but they are too strong and he cannot break free from his people's hold.







Past:

Born amongst the stars. Raised in the Maginist Tower by Benna, a top-level Maginist (magic-user) and member of the High Council. Grew up learning how to utilise Magence (magic) alongside his fellow Maginists.

Present:

Struggles to connect with others, due to being autistic. Feels that he doesn't fit in with his fellow Maginists, due to being a Sar Arsam. Frightened by the over-enthusiastic Maginists, Acolytes (Maginist assistants), and servants professing their love for him. Hopes to find true love, and his place in the world, and eventually does, but this discovery frees the monster lurking within him.













BENNA [UNKNOWN]

Benna is a top-level Maginist (magic-user), who adopted Elias and raised him as a Maginist. He couldn't be more involved in Elias' life, as though he was his biological father.

DANBO [17]

Danbo is Elias' best friend and Acolyte (Maginist assistant). Benna found him as a newborn, his brothers and sisters dead, and their mother and father missing. He's usually right by Elias' side, helping him cope with life, and offering encouragement.

GALEA [16]

Galea was a mystery to all when she was born, the odd one out among her herd. She formed a close bond with Elias, who understood what it means to be unique, eventually falling in love with him.



RENSA [18]

Rensa has always been a thorn in Elias' side. He was encouraged by his father, Karna, to continue the 'family tradition' of tormenting Elias. He enjoys tormenting Elias. He sees himself as far superior, in every way. And he wants Galea.

The Sar Ala still attack on occasion, unwilling to give up this world they've created.










MEETS


